Access Policy

Due to a limited number of seats, library access is only provided to students who are actively engaged in a course. The access policy is as follows:

- 1) You must be enrolled in an active course which requires resources from the virtual library or be a facilitator/teacher for a course.
- 2) You must have accessed the eLearning Centre within the last 14 days. Your access to the library is discontinued after 14 days of inactivity. The access is automatically reinstated as soon as you become active in the eLearning Centre and are enrolled in an active course which requires resources from the virtual library.






LOGGING INTO VIRTUAL LIBRARY

- 1) You can access Virtual Library directly at https://library.desouzainstitute.com.
- 2) You can also access Virtual Library by going to www.desouzainstitute.com.
 - a. Click **LOGIN** (button, top right)
 - b. Then click on Virtual Library (third button on the right)



3) Enter your username (email address) and password then click Log In.




4) You are now logged into Virtual Library.



YOUR VIRTUAL LIBRARY HOME SCREEN

After you have logged into **Virtual Library** you will have access to over 2700 eJournals, 190 eBooks and 9 online databases. You can search through all these resources using the search functions on the main page. If you are unsure how to execute a search be sure to consult the resources in the **Help** section that are available in the Library Menu on the left side of the page.






Accessing Resources

There are two main ways to access resources in the virtual library the first is using the search function which searches for keywords in the titles of the resources in the library and the second is by browsing the alphabetical list of titles.

USING THE SEARCH FEATURE


- First you must decide if you wish to search the entire virtual library collection or one of the three main categories of the library eJournals, eBooks, or Databases. In the menu on the left of the screen click either All Collections to search everything or click one of the categories, eJournals, eBooks or Databases.
- 2. In the space provided type a keyword that you wish to search for and click **Search**. The system will search the titles of the library resources for your keyword and will display the matching results below.
- 3. Click **Add Another Row** to refine or expand your search.
 - To *expand* your search type another keyword in the space beside the word 'OR' and click Search. The results that are returned will contain *either* of the keywords typed.
 - To *refine* your search click the down arrow beside the word 'OR' and click the word 'AND'. Type another keyword in the box beside the word 'AND' and click Search. The results returned will now contain *both* of the keywords typed.





BROWSING RESOURCES ALPHABETICALLY

- Again you must decide if you wish to view the entire virtual library collection or one of the three
 main categories of the library eJournals, eBooks, or Databases. In the menu on the left of the
 screen click either All Collections to view everything or click one of the categories, eJournals,
 eBooks or Databases.
- 2. The list that appears will be an alphabetical list of all titles in that category. You can quickly skip through this exhaustive list by clicking the letters of the alphabet that are above the list.



ADVANCED SEARCHING

You can use the databases listed to conduct more advanced searches. Each database has its own process for searching for information. You can find further information on how to use the different databases by clicking *Help* in the Library Menu on the left side of the page or by using any tutorials that are provided on the main page of the database.
